CONSIDERATION OF CHANGE ORDER FOR WESTLAND FOR GALVANIZED SERVICES

The services for 1325, 1327, 1329 Spruce are connected on the south side. A single 1" galvanized line currently feeds all three locations. Preliminary investigations discovered galvanized between the services, but field and records showed copper line coming across. The bid price for a long service is \$1,600 each, for a total of \$4,800 and two additional work days. Upon motion from Director Norris, seconded by Director Gervasini, the motion passed 5-0.

RESOLVED (No. 14831), that the Board authorized the General Manager to execute a change order with Westland Construction Inc for the additional service line replacements totaling \$4,800.00 and 2 contract days work.
