CONSIDERATION OF CONTRACT WITH MCCLURE ENGINEERING CO.	The General Manager presented a consulting services agreement with McClure Engineering Company for the relocation of the transmission main leaving the North Plant due to the New Centennial Bridge project. Noted that the engineering for this project will take considerable time to locate buried utilities and be certain we will avoid all the underground utilities and pipelines.		
	The total dollar amount is calculated at time and material, with a not to exceed total. This contract is for services through the award of the construction contract. The GM noted the understanding is that KDOT will pay for the engineering, but that has not confirmed this at this time.
